"Mr. Speaker, I just wanted to say a couple of things in support of HB 29. I am in support in the sense of raising a number of questions, which this bill probably responds to. This is, by the way, the 'cadaver bill'. The Human Bodies bill. And it raises probably more questions than it may answer. It's provocative.

"But my concern is that the next Committee look at the line in the sand between science and commercialism and exploitation; between the need to educate and the need to tillate. And, quite frankly, I was in Red Square. I saw Lenin, looking at that for scientific, historical purposes. We see fetuses that are less than eight weeks old to show you what abortion can do. There's a number of things that this kind of opens the box up for.

"I just wanted to say for the next Committee that looks at this, please don't get overtaken with the commercial aspect, but be very scientifically exacting and beware of geopolitical motives, which I think are somewhat underlying within this bill. Thank you, Speaker."

Representative Marumoto rose to speak in support of the measure with reservations, stating:

"Mr. Speaker, I rise to speak in favor of this measure, but to express some reservations. I have no desire to attend the exhibit that is now at one of our shopping centers, but I have no objection if other people do wish to visit this exhibit. I understand it's quite remarkable.

"My objection to this particular resolution has to do with the governmental functions that will attend this bill. The Department of Health did not want to administrate this program, and suggested another department do it. It would take certain people to run the program to be experts in it. And there's a fee involved in it to cover the administrative expenses of this program, and I'm not sure any fee would be sufficient to administrate this program and pay for the expertise.

"So, I just think that we should take another look at this before we move this measure on final passage. Thank you"

I am writing to inform you that I have received orders from the Hawaii Army National Guard to serve our country in Kuwait for six months. I will be deployed beginning February 4, 2009, with the Hawaii Army National Guard's 29<sup>th</sup> Brigade Combat Team.
