the Executive Office on Aging and the Joint Legislative Committee on Family Caregiving, 80% of employers surveyed offer paid bereavement leave while only 4.7% of the employees surveyed knew of this benefit. Over 66% of the employers also offer leave without pay, but only 5% of the employees knew about it. By making this information available to employees, this bill would help family caregivers and others to plan ahead for family emergencies and to avoid taking actions which might affect their retirement benefits.

"Mr. Speaker, doing more to inform workers about their employment rights is always a good thing, and Hawaii's employees need easy access to this information. We are just two years away from the first of the baby boomers to reach 65, and the need will only continue to escalate as our community ages.

"I urge my fellow colleagues to support HD319 HD1."
