A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 **PART I**

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the
3 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining
4 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, to fund for fiscal biennium 2015-2017 all
6 collective bargaining cost items for salary increases and other
7 wage related costs in the agreement negotiated with the
8 exclusive bargaining representative of collective bargaining
9 unit (2):

1 SECTION 7. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
2 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
3 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
4 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
5 from the respective funds.

6 SECTION 8. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
7 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2016, and
8 June 30, 2017, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of
9 those dates.

10 SECTION 9. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect
11 on July 1, 2015.
