A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO USE PERMITS FOR SMALL BOAT HARBORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 200-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) In order to obtain a permit~~[7]~~ or a permit renewal,
4 ~~[or to be placed on a waitlist for a permit7]~~ the owner of a
5 vessel shall provide, at the owner's own expense:

6 (1) A marine surveyor's inspection or a vessel inspection
7 by the department, no more than two years old,
8 certifying that ~~[the surveyor has inspected]~~ the
9 vessel has been inspected and ~~[considers it to~~
10 ~~fulfill]~~ fulfills the requirements set by the
11 department;

12 (2) Documentation that the person is the owner of the
13 vessel. The documentation shall meet requirements
14 established by the department; and

15 (3) Satisfactory proof that the person has attained the
16 age of eighteen years~~[7]~~ prior to obtaining a permit
17 or being placed on the waitlist for a permit."




1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
