A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VETERANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow the
2 department of education to continue, until June 30, 2020,
3 awarding high school diplomas to qualified veterans who did not
4 receive a high school diploma as a result of compulsory
5 induction into active service in the armed services of the
6 United States or any person whose high school education was
7 interrupted due to wartime practices such as internment during
8 World War II.

9 SECTION 2. Act 133, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, is
10 amended by amending section 75 to read as follows:

11 "SECTION 75. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
12 provided that section 38 shall take effect on June 30, [~~2015~~]
13 2020."

14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2015.
