A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIVIL LEGAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that legal services are
- 2 often prohibitively expensive for low- and moderate-income
- 3 persons. The legislature further finds that several nonprofit
- 4 and volunteer organizations in the State provide quality legal
- 5 services to persons who require, but lack the resources to pay
- 6 for, services. These organizations include, without limitation,
- 7 Volunteer Legal Services Hawai'i, Domestic Violence Action
- 8 Center, and the Legal Aid Society of Hawai'i. While these
- 9 organizations generally function on a volunteer or not-for-
- 10 profit basis, they still require funding for operating costs and
- 11 other expenses. The legislature has regularly made annual
- 12 appropriations for the judiciary to secure civil legal services
- 13 for low- and moderate-income persons and in 2022 appropriated
- 14 \$1.2 million for this purpose.
- The purpose of this Act is to support nonprofit and
- 16 volunteer organizations that provide legal services to low- and

- 1 moderate-income persons by appropriating funds for the judiciary
- 2 to purchase civil legal services for these persons.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,200,000 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
- 6 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 7 2024-2025 for the purchase of civil legal services for low- and
- 8 moderate-income persons.
- 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
- 10 for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
