BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 396, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§396- Occupational safety and health special fund;
5	establishment; purposes. (a) There is established within the
6	state treasury the occupational safety and health special fund,
7	to be administered by the department, into which shall be
8	deposited:
9	(1) Fees collected pursuant to section 396-5.1; and
10	(2) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund.
11	All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited into the
12	occupational safety and health special fund shall become part of
13	the special fund.
14	(b) Moneys in the occupational safety and health special
15	fund shall be expended by the department for the following
16	purposes:
17	(1) Personnel and operating expenses; and

1	(2) Staff development and training fees and expenses.
2	(c) The unencumbered balance of the occupational safety
3	and health special fund exceeding \$ at the end of each
4	fiscal year shall be deposited into the general fund on or about
5	June 30 every year."
6	SECTION 2. Section 396-5.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
8	"(b) Fees received pursuant to subsection (a) shall be
9	deposited into the [general fund.] occupational health and
10	safety special fund established pursuant to section 396"
11	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
