A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of Hawaiian home lands may
- 2 administer an undivided interest award program for
- 3 beneficiaries. The program may award an undivided interest to
- 4 any beneficiary who is:
- 5 (1) Sixty years or older; or
- 6 (2) Terminally ill;
- provided that the beneficiary may designate a successor upon 7
- 8 receipt of the undivided interest award.
- Any eliqible heir of a beneficiary who passed away 9
- 10 while on the waiting list shall have four years from the
- effective date of this Act to file a successorship claim for a 11
- 12 posthumous undivided interest award to the named deceased
- 13 beneficiary.
- The department of Hawaiian home lands shall adopt 14
- rules pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to 15
- 16 administer this Act within one year of the effective date of
- 17 this Act.

Beneficiaries; Undivided Interest Award; Successors; Successorship Claims; Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

Description:

Authorizes beneficiaries, who are sixty years or older or terminally ill, to receive an undivided interest award and to designate a successor. Authorizes any eligible heirs of beneficiaries to file successorship claims within a certain timeframe, including posthumous undivided interest awards. Requires the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands to adopt rules by a certain date.
