
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO
CLEARLY DELINEATE OR DISTINGUISH PROPERTY BOUNDARIES TO
ENSURE THAT HUNTING ACTIVITIES ARE OCCURRING ON DESIGNATED
LANDS.

1 WHEREAS, the powers and duties of the Department of Land
2 and Natural Resources pursuant to chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised
3 Statutes, include managing and administering the wildlife
4 resources and enforcing the wildlife hunting laws of the State;
5 and

7 WHEREAS, there have been incidents where hunters have
8 hunted outside of public hunting areas and trespassed onto
9 private lands; and
10

11 WHEREAS, because the boundaries between hunting areas open
12 to the public and private lands are sometimes unmarked, some
13 hunters may unintentionally crossover into private lands; and
14

15 WHEREAS, there have also been incidents where livestock
16 have been killed by hunters trespassing on private lands; and
17

18 WHEREAS, because the Department of Land and Natural
19 Resources is responsible for enforcing wildlife hunting laws in
20 the State, the Department should clearly delineate or
21 distinguish property boundaries between hunting areas open to
22 the public and private lands to ensure that hunters stay within
23 designated areas for hunting; now, therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
26 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
27 Session of 2024, that the Department of Land and Natural
28 Resources is requested to clearly delineate or distinguish
29 property boundaries to ensure that hunting activities are
30 occurring on designated lands; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
2 Natural Resources is requested to consider designating lands
3 that do not abut private lands as public hunting areas, in order
4 to avoid the intentional and unintentional crossover of hunters
5 onto private lands; and

8 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of
9 Land and Natural Resources.
