| 11 | (2) For the second offense, an additional fine of \$500; |

| 13 | (3) For the third or subsequent offense occurring within |
| 14 | eighteen months of a first offense: |
| 15 | (A) An additional fine of \$1000; and |
| 16 | (B) Revocation of license and privilege to operate a |
| 17 | vehicle for a period of one year." |
