The purpose and intent of this measure is to urge a transition to a plant-based lifestyle.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Vegan Society of Hawaii, Inc.; Hawaii Reef and Ocean Coalition; Climate Protectors Hawaii; Citizens' Climate Lobby Hawaii; Building Decarbonization Task Force of the Hawaii Environmental Change Agents; Kauai Climate Action Coalition; Green Party of Hawaii, Down to Earth; Hawaii Food & Policy and eleven individuals.

Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Agriculture and Hawaii Cattlemen's Council, Inc.

Your Committee finds that a plant-based lifestyle fosters a holistic approach to environmental stewardship, cultural preservation, and community well-being. Your Committee recognizes that Hawaii's tropical climate, with a year-round growing season, is well-suited to support plant-based lifestyles. This measure urges the transition to a plant-based lifestyle as it can have an

enormous positive impact on reducing the effects of climate change.
