Affairs, & Culture and the Arts, to which was referred S.C.R. No.  
57, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXPANDING THE TASK FORCE STUDY  
OF THE EFFECTS OF THE JANUARY 2014 FUEL TANK LEAK AT THE RED  
HILL UNDERGROUND FUEL STORAGE FACILITY, ESTABLISHED UNDER  
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 73, H.D. 1, REGULAR SESSION  
OF 2014, TO INCLUDE AN ADDITIONAL TWENTY-SIX UNDERGROUND FUEL  
STORAGE TANKS IN THE STATE OWNED BY THE UNITED STATES  
MILITARY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to protect the environment and  
public health and safety by:

- (1) Expanding the scope of the task force study on the  
effects of the January 2014 fuel tank leak at the Red  
Hill Underground Fuel Storage Facility, established  
under Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 73, H.D. 1,  
Regular Session of 2014 (SCR73), to include an  
additional 26 underground fuel storage tanks located  
throughout the State and owned by the United States  
military;



- (2) Adding Hawaii's Congressional delegation or their representatives to the membership of the Task Force established by S.C.R. 73;
- (3) Requesting the task force to submit another report to the Legislature to encompass the additional 26 tanks prior to the convening of the 2016 Regular Session; and
- (4) Requesting the task force to continue to monitor the United States Navy's plans for remediation of the Red Hill Underground Fuel Storage Facility fuel tank leaks.

The Department of Land and Natural Resources, Department of Health, Board of Water Supply of the City and County of Honolulu, and a concerned individual supported this measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Veterans, Military, & International Affairs, & Culture and the Arts that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 57, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, and recommends its adoption.


