12	(b)	The department of health shall provide the information

14	(1)	Hospitals licensed pursuant to section 321-14.5;	
15	(2)	Health care providers offering care to pregnant women	
16		and infants;	
17	<u>(3)</u>	Registered family child care homes;	
18	(4)	Licensed group child care centers;
