9	(2)	A geographic exception to attend a school in another
10		service area is requested and granted at the
11		discretion of the department; [ex]
12	(3)	Out-of-service-area attendance is mandated by the
13		department or by federal law[-]; or
14	(4)	The person attends a public charter school and has
15	·	been notified of the prospect of charter revocation or
16		nonrenewal in accordance with section 302D-18 or of
17		closure in accordance with section 302D-19."
