The purpose of this measure is to aid female active duty
service members, as well as female veterans, with their specific
needs and issues by requesting the Office of Veterans' Services to
establish and fund a Veteran Women Services Coordinator position
within the Office and appoint a veteran, or present member or
discharged member of the Hawaii Air or Army National Guard, as the
Coordinator.

The Office of Veterans' Services and Hawaii Military Women's
Task Force Committee provided testimony in support of the measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Veterans, Military, & International Affairs, &
Culture and the Arts that is attached to this report, your
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 19 and
recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
