**GOVERNOR RELEASES \$3.3 MILLION FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS  
IN SENATE DISTRICT 4**

**Honolulu, Hawai‘i** – The Governor recently released \$3,392,388 in funding for three capital improvement projects (CIP) in Honoka‘a and Honomū. The CIP projects that received funding are as follows:

- \$2,642,388.00 for construction to develop subsistence agricultural lots in Honomū.
- \$750,000 to finance design for improvements at Honoka‘a Elementary and Honoka‘a Intermediate and High School to comply with current ADA standards.
  - \$400,000 for architectural barrier removal at Honoka‘a Intermediate and High School.
  - \$300,000 for architectural barrier removal at Honoka‘a Elementary School.

“I’d like to thank Governor Ige for releasing funding to finance design improvements for our Honoka‘a Schools to help them become compliant with current ADA standards,” said Senator Lorraine R. Inouye (District 4 - Hilo, Hāmākua, Kohala, Waimea, Waikoloa, Kona). “I also want to express my gratitude to Chair Aila and the Department of Hawaiian Homelands for continuing the development of homestead lands for our Kānaka Maoli in Honomū.”
