

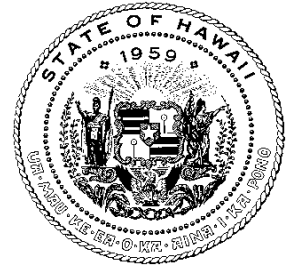

### How to Check Which 2017 Bills Passed the Legislature

A bill that successfully passes out of the Legislature will be sent to the Governor for consideration. To view a complete listing of all the measures that passed:

- Visit [www.capitol.hawaii.gov](http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov)
- Click on "Reports & Lists"
- Scroll down to "Legislature"
- Click on the link "Bills that Passed Legislature"

When a bill becomes a law, it is known as an Act. To view all 2017 Acts:

- Click on "Reports & Lists"
- Scroll under "Deadline Tracking" to "Governor's Actions"
- Click on "List of Acts"
- Click on the Act number to view the Governor's Message and legislation

(35<sup>th</sup> day after Adjournment *sine die*)

**July 11:**  
Veto Deadline
