Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 14
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EDUCATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the transfer of
functions from the Department of Budget and Finance (B&F) to the
Department of Education (DOE) as specified in Act 51, Session Laws
of Hawaii 2004, as amended, as the two departments have improved
the fiscal processes between them.

DOE, B&F, and the Hawaii Government Employees Association
testified in support of this bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by making technical,
nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 14,
as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in
the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 14, H.D. 1.
