Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 24
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TEACHERS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to provide greater incentives for
teachers certified by the National Board for Professional Teaching
Standards to work at a school that is in restructuring under the
No Child Left Behind Act by giving these teachers an additional
\$5,000 bonus per year.

Two individuals testified in support of this bill. The
Department of Education and Hawaii State Teachers Association
testified in support of the intent of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:


- (1) Changing the specified additional annual bonus amount of
\$5,000 to an unspecified amount to facilitate further
discussion; and
- (2) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2020.
