
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IOLANI PALACE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-35, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§6E-35 Iolani Palace.** (a) The official designation of
4 the palace of the former monarchs of Hawaii shall be Iolani
5 Palace.

6 (b) The official designation of the Friends of Iolani
7 Palace shall be the State of Hawaii Museum of Monarchy History.
8 The qualifying standards and conditions related to the receipt
9 of funds under chapter 42F shall not apply to funds received by
10 the State of Hawaii Museum of Monarchy History; provided that if
11 the museum contracts with a recipient or provider, then the
12 qualifying standards, conditions, and other provisions of
13 chapter 42F shall apply to the recipient or provider and the
14 contract.

15 (c) In order to receive state funds, the State of Hawaii
16 Museum of Monarchy History shall:



- 1 (1) Be licensed or accredited, in accordance with federal,
2 state, or county statutes, rules, or ordinances, to
3 conduct the activities or provide the services for
4 which funds are appropriated;
- 5 (2) Comply with all applicable federal and state laws
6 prohibiting discrimination against any person on the
7 basis of race, color, national origin, religion,
8 creed, sex, age, sexual orientation, or disability;
9 and
- 10 (3) Agree not to use the funds for entertainment or
11 lobbying activities.
- 12 (d) In order to receive state funds, the State of Hawaii

13 Museum of Monarchy History shall:

- 14 (1) Be incorporated under the laws of the State;
- 15 (2) Have bylaws or policies that describe the manner in
16 which the activities or services for which a grant or
17 subsidy is awarded shall be conducted or provided;
- 18 (3) Have been determined and designated to be a tax-exempt
19 organization by the Internal Revenue Service; and
- 20 (4) Have a governing board whose members shall have no
21 material conflict of interest and serve without
22 compensation.



1 [~~(e)~~] (e) The comptroller and state auditor shall have the
2 authority to examine the use of funds appropriated to the State
3 of Hawaii Museum of Monarchy History.

4 [~~((d))~~] (f) The State of Hawaii Museum of Monarchy History
5 shall provide to the legislature an annual report no later than
6 twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session,
7 which shall include an explanation of the facility maintenance
8 and other functions accomplished by state fund expenditures in
9 the previous fiscal year."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
