
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-206, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§103D-206 Additional duties of the administrator of the
4 procurement office. In addition to the duties referred to in
5 section 103D-205, the administrator shall:

6 (1) Perform periodic review of the procurement practices
7 of all governmental bodies;

8 (2) Assist, advise, and guide governmental bodies in
9 matters relating to procurement [↗], including
10 determinations of corrective actions; provided that if
11 a procurement officer fails to comply with any
12 determination rendered by the administrator within
13 thirty days from the date of the issuance of the
14 determination, or longer if permitted by the
15 administrator upon request by the procurement officer,
16 the procurement officer shall be subject to an



1 administrative fine under section 103D-106, for every
2 day of noncompliance;

3 (3) Develop and administer a statewide procurement
4 orientation and training program;

5 (4) Develop, distribute, and maintain a procurement manual
6 for all state procurement officials; and

7 (5) Develop, distribute, and maintain a procurement guide
8 for vendors wishing to do business with the State and
9 its counties."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2034.

State Procurement Office; Corrective Actions; Fines

Description:

Allows the State Procurement Office Administrator to make a determination of corrective action and fine procurement officers who fail to comply within 30 days; allows the Administrator to extend the 30 day period. (SB2825 HD1)
