A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AFTER-SCHOOL PLUS PROGRAM REVOLVING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature reaffirms its intent to support
2 the after-school plus program revolving fund primarily through
3 program participant fees. The legislature, however, finds that
4 the program is also being supported in part by general fund
5 appropriations and funds from the department of human services
6 for child care for eligible low income children.

7 The purpose of this Act is to limit deposits into the
8 revolving fund to only those funds that are collected as fees or
9 charges for participation in the program and the interest earned
10 on the revolving fund deposits.

11 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1149.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
12 is amended to read as follows:

13 "~~{~~§302A-1149.5~~}~~ After-school plus program revolving
14 fund. (a) There is established in the state treasury the
15 after-school plus program revolving fund to be administered by
16 the department.

17 (b) The after-school plus program revolving fund shall

13 The revenues from those fees and charges shall be deposited into

14 the revolving fund to be used ~~[to pay the costs of administering~~

15 ~~and operating]~~ for the program."

16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.


