A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CANCER RESEARCH SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 245-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§245-15 Disposition of revenues.** All moneys collected
4 pursuant to this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury
5 as state realizations to be kept and accounted for as provided
6 by law; provided that, of the moneys collected under the tax
7 imposed pursuant to:

8 (1) Section 245-3(a)(5), after September 30, 2006, and
9 prior to October 1, 2007, 1.0 cent per cigarette shall
10 be deposited to the credit of the Hawaii cancer
11 research special fund, established pursuant to section
12 304A-2168, for research and operating expenses[+] and
13 for capital expenditures;

14 (2) Section 245-3(a)(6), after September 30, 2007, and
15 prior to October 1, 2008:

16 (A) 1.5 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
17 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
18 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,



- 1 for research and operating expenses[+] and for
2 capital expenditures;
- 3 (B) 0.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to
4 the credit of the trauma system special fund
5 established pursuant to section 321-22.5; and
- 6 (C) 0.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to
7 the credit of the emergency medical services
8 special fund established pursuant to section 321-
9 234;
- 10 (3) Section 245-3(a)(7), after September 30, 2008, and
11 prior to October 1, 2009:
- 12 (A) 2.0 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
13 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
14 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,
15 for research and operating expenses[+] and for
16 capital expenditures;
- 17 (B) 0.5 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
18 credit of the trauma system special fund
19 established pursuant to section 321-22.5;
- 20 (C) 0.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to
21 the credit of the community health centers
22 special fund; and



1 (D) 0.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to
2 the credit of the emergency medical services
3 special fund established pursuant to section 321-
4 234;

5 (4) Section 245-3(a)(8), after September 30, 2009, and
6 prior to October 1, 2010:

7 (A) 2.0 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
8 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
9 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,
10 for research and operating expenses[+] and for
11 capital expenditures;

12 (B) 0.75 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to
13 the credit of the trauma system special fund
14 established pursuant to section 321-22.5;

15 (C) 0.75 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to
16 the credit of the community health centers
17 special fund; and

18 (D) 0.5 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
19 credit of the emergency medical services special
20 fund established pursuant to section 321-234;

21 (5) Section 245-3(a)(9), after September 30, 2010, and
22 prior to October 1, 2011:

- 1 (A) 2.0 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
2 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
3 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,
4 for research and operating expenses[+] and for
5 capital expenditures;
- 6 (B) 1.0 cent per cigarette shall be deposited to the
7 credit of the trauma system special fund
8 established pursuant to section 321-22.5;
- 9 (C) 1.0 cent per cigarette shall be deposited to the
10 credit of the community health centers special
11 fund; and
- 12 (D) 1.0 cent per cigarette shall be deposited to the
13 credit of the emergency medical services special
14 fund established pursuant to section 321-234; and
- 15 (6) Section 245-3(a)(10), after September 30, 2011, and
16 thereafter:
- 17 (A) 2.0 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
18 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
19 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,
20 for research and operating expenses[+] and for
21 capital expenditures;



1 (B) 1.5 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
2 credit of the trauma system special fund
3 established pursuant to section 321-22.5;

4 (C) 1.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to
5 the credit of the community health centers
6 special fund; and

7 (D) 1.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to
8 the credit of the emergency medical services
9 special fund established pursuant to section 321-
10 234.

11 The department shall provide an annual accounting of these
12 dispositions to the legislature."

13 SECTION 2. Section 304A-2168, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 "**§304A-2168 Hawaii cancer research special fund.** (a)

16 There is established within the state treasury a special fund to
17 be known as the Hawaii cancer research special fund to be
18 administered and expended by the University of Hawaii.

19 (b) The moneys in the special fund shall be used by the
20 University of Hawaii for the cancer research center of Hawaii's
21 research and operating expenses[-] and capital expenditures.



1 (c) The following shall be deposited into the special
2 fund:

3 (1) Moneys collected pursuant to section 245-15; [~~and~~]

4 (2) All other fees, charges, and other moneys received in
5 conjunction with programs of the cancer research
6 center of Hawaii;

7 (3) Transfers from other accounts or funds; and

8 [~~(2)~~] (4) Interest earned or accrued on moneys in the
9 special fund."

10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
