# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF THE JUDICIARY HISTORY CENTER.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 6F-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:  
3           " [f] §6F-3 [f] **Executive board.** (a) The responsibility for  
4 general administration and the proper operation of the center  
5 shall be vested in an executive board to be known as the board  
6 of the judiciary history center. The board shall have power in  
7 accordance with law to formulate policy and to exercise control  
8 over the center. The board shall consist of five members  
9 appointed by the chief justice [7]; provided that three members  
10 shall be selected from a list of seven candidates submitted by  
11 the friends of the judiciary history center. The term of each  
12 member shall be for four years, commencing on July 1, and  
13 expiring on June 30; provided that of the five members appointed  
14 for terms commencing July 1, 1990, two members shall serve for  
15 four years, two members shall serve for three years, and one  
16 member shall serve for two years. The members shall serve  
17 without compensation but they shall be reimbursed for travel and



1 other necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their  
2 official duties.

3 (b) A vacancy on the board shall be filled for the  
4 remainder of the unexpired term or, if expired, for a new term  
5 by the chief justice; provided that a vacancy in any one of the  
6 three positions originally appointed by the chief justice from a  
7 list submitted by the friends of the judiciary history center  
8 shall be filled by the chief justice from a list of three  
9 candidates submitted by the friends of the judiciary history  
10 center."

11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
