
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE U.S. NAVY TO CLEAR THE COASTLINE OF LOWER WAIPAHU UNDER THEIR JURISDICTION FROM INVASIVE PLANT-LIFE AND EXCESSIVE FOLIAGE FOR SAFETY AND AESTHETIC PURPOSES.

1 WHEREAS, the shoreline of lower Waipahu has, in recent
2 years, become subject to significant overgrowth by various
3 invasive plant species and excessive foliage, therefore creating
4 not only a shabby appearance, but also a safety hazard and an
5 area where illicit activities may potentially transpire; and

7 WHEREAS, the shoreline along West Loch and Middle Loch
8 within the U.S. Navy's jurisdiction is strewn with abandoned
9 vehicles, tires, white goods and other discarded debris; now,
10 therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
13 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
14 Session of 2008, that the U.S. Navy is requested to clear the
15 section of lower Waipahu adjacent to West Loch Estates under
16 their jurisdiction from invasive plant-life and excessive
17 foliage for safety and aesthetic purposes; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that duly certified copies of this
20 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President, National
21 Security Advisor, Secretary of Defense, Deputy Secretary of
22 Defense, JCS Chairman, all members of the Joint Staff, all
23 members of the NSC, the Secretaries of the Air Force, Army, and
24 Navy, CDRUSPACOM, USPACFLT, the Waipahu Community Association,
25 the Chair of the Waipahu Neighborhood Board, and the Mayor of
26 the City and County of Honolulu.
