5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$130,000,000, or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
8 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
9 year 2008-2009, for the department of education's repair and
10 maintenance projects.

11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
12 of education for the purposes of this part.

13 SECTION 3. Sums appropriated under this part shall be in
14 addition to any funds that may be appropriated for the same
15 purposes of this part.

16 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for capital improvement
17 projects authorized by section 2 of this Act shall not lapse at
18 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.



1 this part is to reduce the backlog of repair and maintenance
2 projects at the University of Hawaii to a manageable level.

3 SECTION 6. The director of finance is authorized to issue
4 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$80,000,000, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
6 sum of \$60,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for
7 fiscal year 2008-2009, and the same sums, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, are appropriated for the purpose of reducing
9 the backlog or repair and maintenance projects to manageable
10 levels at the University of Hawaii system.

11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
12 of Hawaii for the purposes of this part.

13 SECTION 7. The sums appropriated under this part shall be
14 in addition to any other funds that may be appropriated for the
15 same purposes of this part.

16 SECTION 8. The appropriations made for the capital
17 improvement projects authorized by section 6 of this Act shall
18 not lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the
19 appropriations are made; provided that all moneys from the
20 appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as
21 of that date.



PART III

SECTION 9. Section 302A-1506.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

"[+]§302A-1506.5[+] **Early childhood education facilities; identifying sites[-]; inspections.** (a) The department of education shall identify unused public school facilities for use by early childhood education programs. Suitable empty classrooms, as determined by the department, shall be [invented for potential use in] prepared and utilized for early childhood education programs[-]; provided that the classrooms shall meet the licensing standards determined by the departments of education and human services. Priority shall be given to land or facilities on sites with sufficient space for three or more classrooms to be renovated or constructed.

(b) The department shall assist in the identification of possible construction sites for private providers to build early childhood education facilities.

(c) The department shall inspect each early childhood education program facility as frequently as it deems necessary for the proper operation, sanitation, and safety of the facility. The inspections shall be made at least once a year.

All early education program facilities shall be open at all

1 times to visitation and inspection by representatives of the
2 departments of education, human services, and health, and by the
3 designated representatives of the respective county fire
4 departments.

5 (d) The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
6 to effectuate this section."

10 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007;
11 provided that section 9 shall take effect upon approval.
