# SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO CHANGE THE HAWAII ADMINISTRATIVE RULES TO ALLOW CHILDREN WHO ARE HOME SCHOOLED TO PARTICIPATE IN PUBLIC SCHOOL CO-CURRICULAR OR EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.

1           WHEREAS, co-curricular or extracurricular activities,  
2 including athletics, play an important role in the holistic  
3 development of a child; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, Hawaii's public school system, as well as the  
6 Department of Human Services, affords public school students the  
7 opportunity to participate in numerous before-school and after-  
8 school activities that enhance their development as contributing  
9 members of our communities; and  
10

11           WHEREAS, section 302B-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, affords  
12 charter school students the right to participate in athletic  
13 programs at public schools; and  
14

15           WHEREAS, home schooled students need to have a well-  
16 balanced education, similar to public school and charter school  
17 students; and  
18

19           WHEREAS, home schooled students lack the same recreational  
20 enrichment provided by co-curricular or extracurricular  
21 activities available to public school students; and  
22

23           WHEREAS, based on the number of 4140 forms filed, the  
24 Department of Education has 9,147 students formally registered  
25 as home schooled students; and  
26

27           WHEREAS, parents of home schooled students must pay for  
28 their children's curriculum and supplies, but must also pay  
29 taxes to support the public financing of the Department of  
30 Education's \$2.4 billion budget; and

32           WHEREAS, subsection 8-12-13(d), Hawaii Administrative Rules  
33 (HAR) provides that the parents of a home schooled student are



1 responsible for the child's total educational program, including  
2 athletics and co-curricular activities; now, therefore,

3  
4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth  
5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008,  
6 that the Department of Education is requested to change the HAR  
7 to allow children who are home schooled to participate in public  
8 school co-curricular or extracurricular activities; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
11 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of  
12 Education and Superintendent of Education.
