A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOBACCO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to continue the
2 requirement that businesses engaged in the sale of cigarettes
3 and other tobacco products at the retail level acquire a retail
4 tobacco permit from the department of taxation to engage in such
5 activity. Act 131, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, which enacted
6 the requirement of a retail tobacco permit, contains a sunset
7 clause that will repeal Act 131 on July 1, 2009.

8 The legislature finds that the retail tobacco permit
9 program has facilitated the enforcement of chapter 245, Hawaii
10 Revised Statutes, and has resulted in an increase in taxes
11 collected. Consequently, this Act removes the sunset clause and
12 keeps in place the requirement that an entity engaged in the
13 retail sale of cigarettes or other tobacco products obtain a
14 retail tobacco permit.

15 SECTION 2. Act 131, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is
16 amended by amending section 9 to read as follows:



1 "SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
2 provided that [+

9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 2009.
