## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO  
IMPLEMENT AN ELECTRONIC DIRECT DEPOSIT SYSTEM FOR MEMBERS  
OF THE HAWAII NATIONAL GUARD WHILE ON ACTIVE DUTY IN  
ACCORDANCE WITH ACT 31, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII 2007.

1           WHEREAS, members of our Hawaii National Guard have served  
2 Hawaii and the United States with distinction for decades; and  
3

4           WHEREAS, Hawaii National Guard members selflessly give of  
5 their time to not only serve in combat operations, but also in  
6 local security efforts, disaster response, and community  
7 activities; and  
8

9           WHEREAS, Hawaii National Guard members deserve to receive  
10 fair and timely compensation for their generous service; and  
11

12           WHEREAS, the electronic direct deposit of paychecks is a  
13 standard payroll method which enhances government efficiency by  
14 reducing the workload and expense of manual processing and  
15 distribution; and  
16

17           WHEREAS, direct deposit eliminates the possibility of lost  
18 paychecks and ensures timely access to earned personal funds;  
19 and

21           WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 1968, introduced during the 2007  
22 legislative session, proposed to require that the State allow  
23 officers, warrant officers, and enlisted personnel of the Hawaii  
24 National Guard to directly deposit their pay by electronic means  
25 into their personal banking accounts while on active duty; and

27           WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii Department of Defense, the  
28 Hawaii National Guard Association, and the Chamber of Commerce  
29 of Hawaii all testified in strong support of the measure; and

1           WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 1968 passed the Legislature and  
2 was signed into law as Act 31 by Governor Linda Lingle on April  
3 20, 2007; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, to date, a direct deposit system has yet to be  
6 implemented; now, therefore,  
7

8           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
9 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
10 of 2009, the Senate concurring, that the Department of  
11 Accounting and General Services is requested to implement an  
12 electronic direct deposit system for members of the Hawaii  
13 National Guard while on active duty in accordance with Act 31,  
14 Session Laws of Hawaii 2007; and

16           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
17 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, State  
18 Comptroller, and State Adjutant General.
