# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the  
2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2010.

3           SECTION 2. Act 139, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is amended  
4 by amending part II to read as follows:

5                               **"PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

6           SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be  
7 sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated  
8 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of funding  
9 specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium beginning July  
10 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The total expenditures and the  
11 number of permanent positions established in each fiscal year of  
12 the fiscal biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position  
13 ceilings indicated for each year, except as provided in this Act.

1 SECTION 3. Act 139, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is amended  
2 by amending part IV to read as follows:

3 "PART IV. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

4 SECTION 8. The sum of [~~\$9,775,000~~] \$15,262,000 appropriated  
5 or authorized in Part II of this Act for capital improvement  
6 projects shall be expended by the judiciary for the projects listed  
7 below; provided that several related or similar projects may be  
8 combined into a single project, if a combination is advantageous or  
9 convenient for implementation; and provided further that the total  
10 cost of the projects thus combined shall not exceed the total of  
11 the sums specified for the projects separately. The amount after  
12 each cost element and the total funding for each project listed in  
13 this Part is in thousands of dollars.

1 SECTION 4. Act 139, Session Laws of Hawaii, 2009, is  
2 amended by amending part V, sections 9 and 10, to read as  
3 follows:

4 "SECTION 9. General obligation bonds may be issued, as  
5 provided by law, to yield the amount that may be necessary to  
6 finance projects authorized in Part II and listed in Part IV of  
7 this Act; provided that the sum total of the general obligation  
8 bonds so issued shall not exceed [~~\$9,775,000.~~] \$15,262,000.

9 SECTION 10. Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the  
10 appropriations under Act 169, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007,  
11 section 15, as amended and renumbered by Act 102, Session Laws  
12 of Hawaii 2008, section 4, in the amounts indicated or balances  
13 thereof, unallotted, allotted, unencumbered, or encumbered and  
14 unrequired, are hereby lapsed:

19 SECTION 5. If any portion of this Act or its application  
20 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any  
21 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall  
22 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is  
23 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall





1 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to  
2 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the  
3 extent possible.

4 SECTION 6. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or  
5 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice  
6 is authorized to correct the error. All changes made pursuant  
7 to this section shall be reported to the legislature at its next  
8 regular session.

9 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
