
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE SUN SCREENING DEVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-21.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 3 "(d) This section shall not apply to:
- 4 (1) Rearview mirrors;
- 5 (2) Adjustable nontransparent sun visors [~~which~~] that are
6 mounted forward of the side windows and are not
7 attached to the glazing material;
- 8 (3) Signs, stickers, or other materials [~~which~~] that are
9 displayed in a seven-inch square in the lower corner
10 of the windshield farthest removed from the driver or
11 signs, stickers, or other materials [~~which~~] that are
12 displayed in a five-inch square in the lower corner of
13 the windshield nearest the driver;
- 14 (4) Rear trunk lid handle or hinges;
- 15 (5) Window wipers and window wiper motors;
- 16 (6) Transparent sun screening film materials [~~which~~] that
17 are installed, affixed, or applied [~~along the top edge~~
18 of] to any portion of the windshield so long as [~~such~~]



1 ~~the materials [do not encroach upon the AS-1 portion~~
2 ~~of the windshield as provided by] when applied to the~~
3 ~~windshield meet the requirements of the Federal Motor~~
4 ~~Vehicle Safety [Standards] Standard 205 [or no lower~~
5 ~~than four inches below the top of the windshield, when~~
6 ~~measured from the middle point of the bottom edge of~~
7 ~~the top windshield moulding if no AS-1 markings can be~~
8 ~~found in the left or right upper margin of the~~
9 ~~windshield];~~

10 (7) Sun screening devices for front side wing vents and
11 windows [~~which,~~] that, when used in conjunction with
12 the glazing material, have a light transmittance of no
13 less than thirty-five per cent plus or minus six per
14 cent;

15 (8) Sun screening devices for side windows necessary for
16 driving visibility [~~which~~] that are to the rear of the
17 driver and for rear windows necessary for driving
18 visibility [~~which,~~] that, when used in conjunction
19 with the glazing material, have a light transmittance
20 of no less than thirty-five per cent plus or minus six
21 per cent;



1 (9) Side windows which are to the rear of the driver and
2 rear windows on vans, minivans, trucks, or buses;
3 provided that the vehicles are equipped with rearview
4 mirrors on both sides; and

5 (10) Privacy drapes, curtains, or blinds, or any
6 combination, installed on the interior of motor
7 homes."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
