
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§302A- Minimum instructional hours per school year.

5 (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the school
6 year shall consist of a minimum number of instructional hours as
7 follows:

8 (1) Not less than one thousand eighty instructional hours
9 for kindergarten through grade five;

10 (2) Not less than one thousand eighty instructional hours
11 for grades six through eight; and

12 (3) Not less than one thousand two hundred sixty
13 instructional hours for grades nine through twelve.

14 (b) This section shall apply to all elementary, middle or
15 intermediate, and high schools, including charter schools,
16 beginning with the 2011-2012 school year."



1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
