# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC ORDER.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Act 84, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended  
2 by Act 77, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, is amended by adding a  
3 new section to read as follows:

4 "SECTION 2A. The Honolulu police department is requested  
5 to prepare a report on the offense of urinating and defecating  
6 in public within the boundaries of the downtown Honolulu area  
7 established by this Act that shall include but not be limited  
8 to:

9 (1) The effectiveness of the offense established by this  
10 Act in deterring the conduct proscribed; and

11 (2) The number of citations issued for this offense for  
12 the two years preceding the date of the report;

13 provided that the Honolulu police department is requested to  
14 submit the report to the legislature no later than twenty days  
15 prior to the convening of the 2012 regular session."

16 SECTION 2. Act 84, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended  
17 by section 1 of Act 77, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, is amended  
18 by amending section 5 to read as follows:

1 "SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval  
2 and shall be repealed on December 31, [~~2012~~] 2014."

3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
