# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO ENFORCE  
PROHIBITIONS TO DETER PARKING IN BICYCLE PATHS.

1           WHEREAS, bicycle paths are set aside for use by bicycles  
2 and pedestrians, and are physically separated from motor  
3 traffic; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, in areas with little parking, cars are often  
6 parked in bicycle paths; and  
7

8           WHEREAS, blocking bicycle paths forces bicyclists to run or  
9 ride out onto the street; and  
10

11           WHEREAS, parking in bicycle paths creates serious dangers  
12 that illegal parking in other areas does not; and  
13

14           WHEREAS, section 291C-123, Hawaii Revised Statutes,  
15 prohibits the parking of any vehicle on a bicycle path, except  
16 under certain conditions; now, therefore,

18           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
19 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
20 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that the City and County of  
21 Honolulu is requested to post fines on official signs that  
22 provide notice that parking in bicycle paths is prohibited, and  
23 to take other appropriate steps to deter parking in bicycle  
24 lanes; and

26           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Honolulu Police Department is  
27 requested to regularly enforce the prohibition against parking  
28 in bicycle paths; and  
29

30           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
31 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the
