# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PURCHASES OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. Chapter 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4       "§103F-       Proposals. Proposals subject to this chapter  
5 shall be:

6       (1) Submitted by provider duly licensed in the State to  
7       conduct the business being sought by the request for  
8       proposals; and

9       (2) For the exact amount to be expended by the State,  
10       regardless of the tax status of the provider."


11       SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
13 begun, before its effective date.

14       SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

15       SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
