15 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
16 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
18 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
19 of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

20 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
21 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the



1 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;

2 provided that:

3 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 8 shall be  
4 expended by the department of education; and

5 (2) The sums appropriated in items 9 and 10 shall be  
6 expended by the department of transportation.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
