SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

DESIGNATING THE PACIFIC AVIATION MUSEUM-PEARL HARBOR AT FORD
ISLAND AS THE STATE MUSEUM OF AEROSPACE HISTORY.

1 WHEREAS, aerospace history experts do not have sufficient
2 opportunity to assist in aerospace preservation efforts,
3 resulting in the loss of a valuable resource in Hawaii's
4 cultural landscape; and
5

6 WHEREAS, the State needs to develop a unified approach to
7 working with the military to preserve aerospace history as
8 required by the National Historic Preservation Act; and
9

10 WHEREAS, no state agency is currently charged with the
11 responsibility of preserving Hawaii's aerospace history; and
12

13 WHEREAS, as a consequence, the experts at the Pacific
14 Aviation Museum-Pearl Harbor act as the State's aerospace
15 history curators; now, therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth
18 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010, the
19 House of Representatives concurring, that the Pacific Aviation
20 Museum-Pearl Harbor is designated as the state museum of
21 aerospace history; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aerospace historical
24 experts at the Pacific Aviation Museum-Pearl Harbor are
25 designated as the curators of the State's historical aerospace
26 artifacts; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as the state museum of
29 aerospace history, the Pacific Aviation Museum-Pearl Harbor is
30 requested to establish, as one of its missions, a service to
31 help the State to maintain and preserve its valuable aerospace
32 artifacts; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Historic Preservation
2 Division of the Department of Land and Natural Resources is
3 requested to include aerospace history as part the State's
4 historic preservation efforts; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the aerospace historical
7 experts at the Pacific Aviation Museum-Pearl Harbor be empowered
8 as aerospace historical consultants to state agencies; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
11 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
12 Board of Land and Natural Resources and the Chairman of the
13 Board of Directors of the Pacific Aviation Museum-Pearl Harbor.
