The purpose of this resolution is to request that lo'i be  
established on the grounds of the state capitol.

Several concerned individuals testified in support of this  
resolution. The Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR)  
provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this resolution by:

- (1) Changing the agency requested to establish the lo'i from  
DLNR to the Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA);
- (2) Requesting OHA to consult native Hawaiian preservation  
and education groups and practitioners to devise a plan;  
and
- (3) Requesting OHA to allow volunteer organizations, taro  
farmers, and individuals to provide labor to establish  
and maintain the lo'i.
