
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR MATCHING GRANTS FOR SPACE EDUCATION
PROGRAMMING SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 to be
4 used by the department of education to award a grant for the
5 provision of space education programming services at the Barbers
6 Point elementary school on the island of Oahu.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
8 education for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 2. The Challenger Center of Hawaii shall formulate
10 a plan to become financially self-sufficient for fiscal year
11 2012-2013 and thereafter, including the use of private
12 donations, fees, and federal grant moneys. The Center shall
13 submit its plan to the legislature no later than twenty days
14 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2012.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
