# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RENTAL MOTOR VEHICLE SURCHARGE TAX.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to maintain a rental  
2 motor vehicle surcharge tax of \$    a day.

3           SECTION 2. Section 251-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
4 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

5           "(a) There is levied and shall be assessed and collected  
6 each month a rental motor vehicle surcharge tax of [~~\$2 a day,~~  
7 ~~except that for the period of September 1, 1999, to August 31,~~  
8 ~~2011, the tax shall be \$3]~~ \$\_\_ a day, or any portion of a day  
9 that a rental motor vehicle is rented or leased. The rental  
10 motor vehicle surcharge tax shall be levied upon the lessor;  
11 provided that the tax shall not be levied on the lessor if:

12           (1) The lessor is renting the vehicle to replace a vehicle  
13 of the lessee that is being repaired; and

14           (2) A record of the repair order for the vehicle is  
15 retained either by the lessor for two years for  
16 verification purposes or by a motor vehicle repair  
17 dealer for two years as provided in section 437B-16."



1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the state highway  
2 fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for  
3 fiscal year 2011-2012 and the same sum or so much thereof as may  
4 be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for the operations and  
5 maintenance of the state highways program.

6 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department  
7 of transportation for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
9 and stricken.

10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
