# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEAF BLOWERS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 342F-30.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending its title and subsection (a) to read:

4 " ~~[+] §342F-30.8 [.]~~ Leaf blowers; restrictions. (a) In any  
5 urban land use district, as designated pursuant to section  
6 205-2, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a leaf  
7 blower within a residential zone or within one hundred feet of a  
8 residential zone in the State, except between the hours of 8:00  
9 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on any day except Sunday or a state or  
10 federal holiday, and between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00  
11 p.m. on Sunday or any state or federal holiday ~~[-]~~; provided that  
12 no leaf blower shall be operated for more than fifteen minutes  
13 per day per one-quarter acre per parcel."

14 2. By amending subsection (e) to read:

15 "(e) For the purposes of this section:

16 "Leaf blower" means any machine used to blow leaves, dirt,  
17 or other debris off sidewalks, driveways, lawns, and other  
18 surfaces.



1        "Parcel" means a legal lot of record. Contiguous parcels  
2 owned by the same individual or entity shall be considered one  
3 parcel for purposes of this section.

4        "State holiday" means any day established as a state  
5 holiday in section 8-1."

6        SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8        SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
