A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTIETH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$89,851,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2011-2012
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 twentieth senatorial district, as follows:

16 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
17 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
18 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
19 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
20 of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended as
3 follows:

- 4 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 9 shall be
5 expended by the department of education; and
6 (2) The sums appropriated in items 10 and 11 shall be
7 expended by the department of transportation.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
