4 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
5 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
6 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
7 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
8 of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

9 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
10 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended as
11 follows:

- 12 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 5 shall be
13 expended by the department of education;
- 14 (2) The sum appropriated in item 6 shall be expended by
15 the department of human services;
- 16 (3) The sums appropriated in item 7 shall be expended by
17 the department of agriculture; and
- 18 (4) The sums appropriated in items 8 and 9 shall be
19 expended by the department of transportation.
