A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINETEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$120,535,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2011-2012
5 for capital improvement projects for the nineteenth senatorial
6 district, as follows:

18 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
 19 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 20 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are
 21 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
 22 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
3 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;
4 provided that:

- 5 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 10 shall be
6 expended by the department of education; and
7 (2) The sum appropriated in item 11 shall be expended by
8 the department of transportation.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
