
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 14, Special Session Laws of 2008, created
2 an early learning council. The early learning council was
3 tasked to develop and administer the early learning system
4 established pursuant to section 302L-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
5 to benefit all children throughout Hawaii, from birth until the
6 time they enter kindergarten. The legislature finds that the
7 early learning council has made great progress toward the
8 development of the early learning system.

9 SECTION 2. (a) The early learning council, with the
10 assistance of the department of education, the department of
11 health, and the department of human services, shall perform a
12 fiscal mapping study to identify sources of funding for the
13 early learning system. The study shall include the
14 identification and development of a direct funding stream,
15 including private funding, donations, and grants, to support the
16 early learning system.



1 (b) The early learning council shall report its progress
2 to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
3 convening of the regular session of 2012.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Early Learning Council; Fiscal Mapping Study

Description:

Requires the early learning council, with assistance from the department of education, the department of health, and the department of human services, to develop a fiscal mapping study. Requires a report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2012. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD2)

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
