Your Committee on Human Services, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 60 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING APRIL AS SEXUAL
ASSAULT AWARENESS AND PREVENTION MONTH,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to recognize April
as Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention Month.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Health, Hawaii Coalition Against Sexual
Assault, The Sex Abuse Treatment Center, Child and Family Service,
American Civil Liberties Union of Hawai'i, YWCA of Hawaii Island,
and three individuals.

Your Committee finds that sexual violence impacts the lives
of many adults and children in Hawaii. Your Committee further
finds that violence in the form of intimate partner abuse, sexual
assault, and stalking can have devastating emotional consequences
that outlast the physical effects. Your Committee also finds that
this measure emphasizes the importance of increasing the general
public's awareness and support of agencies that provide services
to sexual assault victims.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:



- (1) Adding two state agencies and a private entity to the list of recipients of certified copies of this measure; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Human Services that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 60, as amended herein, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto as H.C.R. No. 60, S.D. 1.


