Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred
S.C.R. No. 11, S.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE
HOME FOR LIFE TASK FORCE TO REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS FOR REDUCING BARRIERS TO AGING IN PLACE AND
FACILITATING MULTIGENERATIONAL LIVING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to extend the
deadline for the Home for Life Task Force to report its findings
and recommendations for reducing barriers to aging in place and
facilitating multigenerational living.

Your Committee finds that on the recommendation of the Joint
Legislative Committee on Aging in Place, the Home for Life Task
Force was established, pursuant to S.C.R. No. 7, S.D. 1 (2009), to
coordinate research and action to reduce barriers to aging in
place and to facilitate multigenerational or accessible living.
However, a delay in the appointment of six members of the task
force caused the task force to convene its first meeting
significantly later than anticipated. Your Committee further
finds that the task force has diligently met six times since
beginning its work, but it continues to work on unresolved issues
due to the initial delay. The current deadline for the task force
to report its findings and recommendations to the Legislature is
twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2011.
Your Committee further finds that an extension of the reporting
deadline is necessary for the task force to fulfill its mission.


