
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY TO DEVELOP
STRATEGIES THAT WOULD INCREASE ACCESS TO PUBLIC HOUSING FOR
QUALIFIED APPLICANTS.

1 WHEREAS, homelessness and a shortage of affordable housing
2 continue to be two of the State's most persistent and
3 challenging social problems; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the availability of clean, safe, and decent
6 housing is integral to an individual's or family's emergence
7 from poverty; and
8

9 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Public Housing Authority reports that
10 there are nearly ten thousand people on the waiting list for
11 federal public housing and approximately seven thousand five
12 hundred people on the waiting list for state public housing; and

14 WHEREAS, there are a number of unoccupied public housing
15 units in the State and the Hawaii Public Housing Authority
16 currently maintains and enforces policies that effectively
17 exclude qualified applicants; now, therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
20 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
21 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaii Public Housing
22 Authority is requested to develop strategies that would increase
23 access to public housing for qualified applicants; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Public Housing
26 Authority is requested to submit a report on its findings and
27 recommendations to the Legislature not later than twenty days
28 prior to the convening of the 2012 Regular Session; and
