
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII BOARD OF REGENTS TO STUDY
THE REINTEGRATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE CHANCELLOR OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT MANOA WITH THE OFFICE OF THE
PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SYSTEM.

1 WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Constitution guarantees that the
2 Board of Regents of the University of Hawaii (UH) shall have the
3 exclusive jurisdiction over the internal structure, management,
4 and operation of UH, subject only to the exclusive jurisdiction
5 of the Legislature to identify and enact laws of statewide
6 concern; and

7
8 WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Constitution also specifies that
9 the Board of Regents shall appoint the President of the
10 University to act as its executive officer; and

11
12 WHEREAS, in 2001, UH was reorganized such that UH
13 System and UH-Manoa are no longer led by the same executive
14 officer; and

15
16 WHEREAS, in 2001, the Board of Regents reorganized the
17 organizational structure of the University with the
18 understanding that establishing the Office of the Chancellor of
19 UH-Manoa would incur no additional administrative costs to the
20 University; and

21
22 WHEREAS, the Office of the Chancellor of UH-Manoa now
23 requires an annual operational budget of \$14.7 million; and

24
25 WHEREAS, there has been over \$6.4 million in additional
26 administrative costs at UH-Manoa since the establishment of the
27 Office of the Chancellor of UH-Manoa; now, therefore,


1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
2 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
3 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Board of Regents is
4 respectfully requested to study whether the reintegration of the
5 Office of the Chancellor of UH-Manoa with the Office of the
6 President of the UH System is prudent; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Regents report
9 findings and recommendations to the Legislature no later than 20
10 days prior to the convening of the 2012 Regular Session; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
13 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chair of the UH
14 Board of Regents, the Chancellor of UH-Manoa and the President
15 of the UH System.
