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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide employer  
2 contribution amounts for plan years 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 for  
3 Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund health benefit  
4 plan premiums for public officers and employees pursuant to  
5 section 89-11(g), Hawaii Revised Statutes, due to an impasse in  
6 negotiations on issues involving the employer-union health  
7 benefits trust fund.

8           SECTION 2. The legislature finds that for the employees of  
9 collective bargaining unit (11) and for state officers and  
10 employees who are excluded from collective bargaining and who  
11 belong to the same compensation plans as those officers and  
12 employees within collective bargaining unit (11) for plan years  
13 2011-2012 and 2012-2013, subject to the applicable provisions of  
14 chapters 87A and 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the employer  
15 monthly contributions to the Hawaii employer-union health  
16 benefits trust fund ("trust fund") are as follows:
